FOR DENTAL ASSISTANTS

In this program, students will learn how to take excellent orthodontic records, fabricate removable appliances and retainers, deliver bands and change arch wires.

Students will also learn to communicate with patients on how to carefor their appliances.

Students will have access to online modules that will give them an introduction into Orthodontic Assistant basic skills.

In addition to online modules, students will have 5 days of lectures and hands-on training on the following topics:

- How to take an alginate and PVS impression
- How to set up a patient
- How to take Orthodontics photos
- How to take intraoral digital scans
- Orthodontics materials and instruments
- Orthodontics terminology
- Orthodontics classification
- Separator and band placement
- Wire insertion and ties

1-MONTH EXTERNSHIP

At the completion of the course, students may enroll in an optional one month externship rotation in orthodontic private practices to apply and demonstrate competence in learned skills through real clinical experience in the field.
